# The Unforgivable Sin

- \* At the beginning of his ministry, Jesus openly and plainly spoke about who he was, the long awaited Messiah. He healed everyone and taught everyone. Matt 1-12
- \* We see in Matt 12 that his patience with the Jews finally wears thin and he begins to only speak in parables and train only his disciples. This continues through the rest of the chapters in Matthew.





# Signs missed by the Jews?

- \* Jesus worked many miracles of healing, bringing wholeness into people's lives, forgiving sin and restoring relationships.
- \* Messiah would be from the tribe of Judah: **Genesis 49:10**
- \* Messiah would be a descendant of King David: **2 Samuel 7:12-16**
- \* Messiah was to be born at Bethlehem: **Micah 5:2**
- \* Messiah would arrive before the destruction of the Second Temple: **Daniel 9:24-27**
- \* Messiah would present himself by riding on a donkey: **Zechariah 9:9**
- \* Messiah would be tortured to death: **Psalms 22:1-31**
- \* Messiah's life would match a particular description, including suffering, silence at his arrest and trial, death and burial in a rich man's tomb, and resurrection: **Isaiah 52:13-53:12**



# Matthew 12

- \* Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath Matt vs 1-8
- \* Healing on the Sabbath Matt vs 9-14
- \* Behold my Servant Matt vs 15-21 “Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, And He will declare justice to the **Gentiles**. 19 He will not quarrel nor cry out, Nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets. 20 A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench, Till He sends forth justice to victory; 21 And **in His name Gentiles will trust.**” Isaiah 42:1-4 (740BC)
- \* A House Divided Cannot Stand Matt vs 22-30



# Matthew 12:31-32

- \* Mat 12:31 ¶“Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men.
- \* Mat 12:32 “Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever **speaks against the Holy Spirit**, it will not be forgiven him, either **in this age or in the age to come**.



# A Tree Known by Its Fruit

- \* Mat 12:33 ¶ “Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by its fruit.
- \* Mat 12:34 “Brood of vipers! How can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the **heart** the mouth SPEAK.
- \* Mat 12:35 “A good man out of the good **treasure** of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil **treasure** brings forth evil things.
- \* Mat 12:36 “But I say to you that for every idle word men may SPEAK, they will give account of it in the day of judgment.
- \* Mat 12:37 “For by YOUR WORDS you will be justified, and by YOUR WORDS you will be condemned.”



# They Still Want a Sign

- \* Mat 12:38 ¶ Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, “Teacher, we want to see a sign from You.”
- \* Mat 12:39 ¶ But He answered and said to them, “An evil and adulterous **generation** seeks after a sign, and no sign will be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah.
- \* Mat 12:40 “For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- \* Mat 12:41 “**The men of Nineveh** will rise up in the judgment with **THIS GENERATION** and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and indeed a greater than Jonah is here.
- \* Mat 12:42 “**The queen of the South** will rise up in the judgment with **THIS GENERATION** and condemn it, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and indeed a greater than Solomon is here.
- \* Gentiles will Judge the generation of Israel that rejected Christ.



# The Official Act

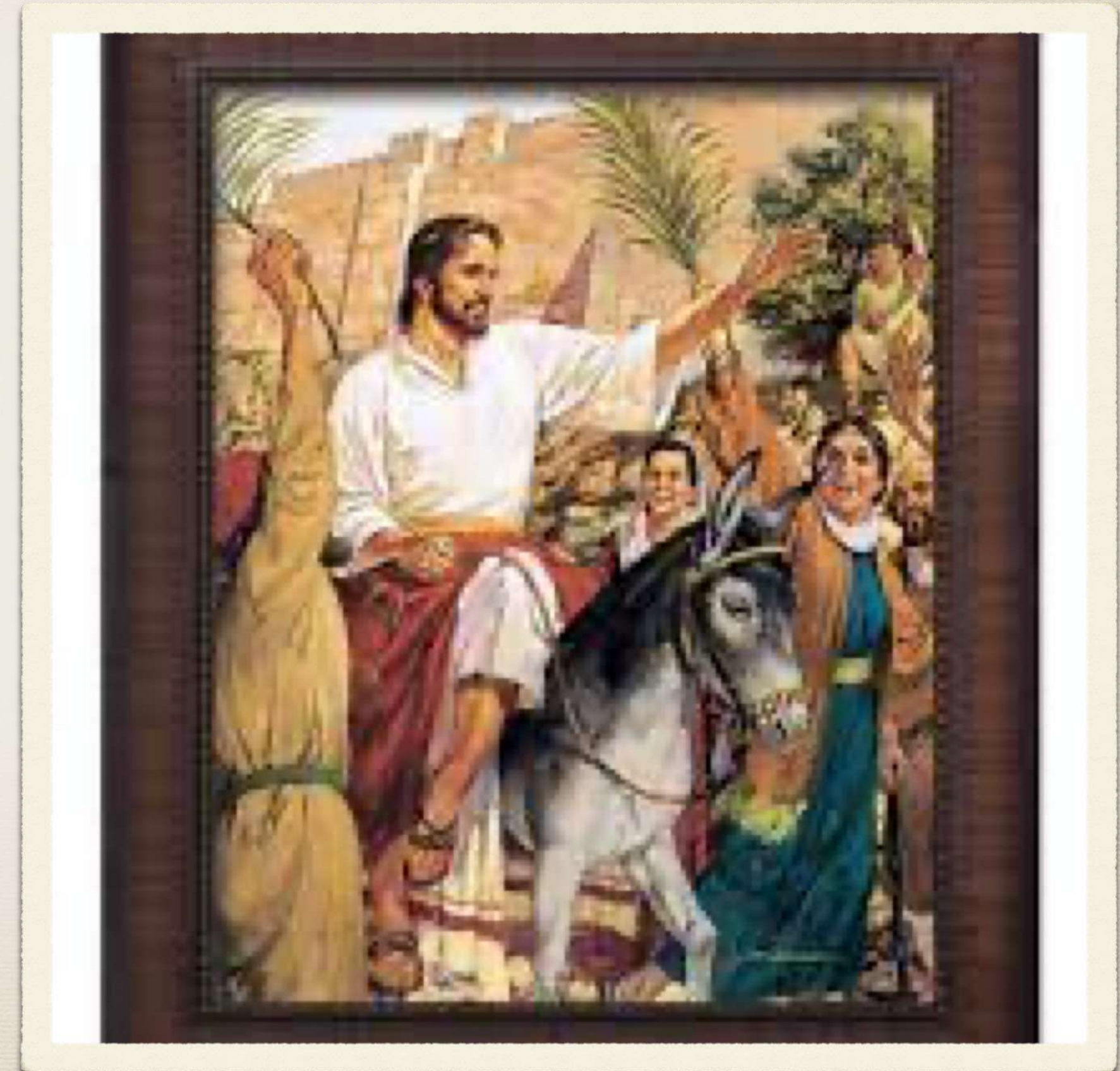
- \* Mat 26:63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, “I put You under oath by the living God: **Tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!**”
- \* Mat 26:64 ¶ Jesus said to him, “**It is as you said.** Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter **YOU WILL SEE** the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven.”
- \* Mat 26:65 ¶ Then the high priest tore his clothes, **saying**, “He has spoken blasphemy! What further need do we have of witnesses? Look, now you have heard His blasphemy!”
- \* Mat 26:66 “What do you think?” They answered and said, “He is deserving of death.”
- \* Mat 26:67 ¶ Then they spat in His face and beat Him; and others struck Him with the palms of their hands,
- \* Mat 26:68 saying, “Prophecy to us, Christ! Who is the one who struck You?”





# Jesus Demand Of Israel

- \* Luk 13:34 ¶ **“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem,** the one who **kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her!** How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, **but you were not willing!**
- \* Luk 13:35 “See! Your house is left to you desolate; and assuredly, I say to you, **you shall not see Me until the time comes when you say, ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!’ ”**
- \* Mat 26:64 ¶ Jesus said to him, **“It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter YOU WILL SEE the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven.”**





# Quick Summary

- \* So we see that Jesus fulfilled what the prophets explained, the characteristics of the Jewish Messiah would be. And, despite the evidence, the Jews of that generation, committed the unpardonable sin, by rejecting Jesus.
- \* We also see that Jesus quotes the prophet Isaiah about his shift from his offer to the Jews, to presenting himself to the gentiles.
- \* We see that Jesus proclaims that it will be Gentiles that will Judge the Jewish Generation that rejected him and the code they will be judged by, will be their own words.
- \* We also see that an official act by a countries leaders, create the judgement for the entire nation. At least, for that generation. Side note, Elections Matter.
- \* “Blessed is he who comes in the Name of The Lord” - Israel has a way to be redeemed.

# Psalms 22 The Good Shepherd

- \* Through Psalms 22 we must remember that this is a cry of agony by David. Written 1000 yrs before Christ.
- \* But we also see the story of the cross, a story of redemption
- \* Vs 1-21 are about the suffering of David, which shadows the suffering of Jesus at the cross.
- \* Vs 22-31 give us a glimpse of a future Israel that will worship The Lord.
- \* John 10:11 “I am the **good shepherd**. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.





# Psalms 23 - The Great Shepherd

- \* This is a chapter of the life of the believer. From beginning to end you will see that our path is always, a walk with Jesus.
- \* Vs 1 is when we become Born Again
- \* Vs 2 - 5 Is our walk through Life.
- \* Vs 6 is our death and our glorious life with the Lord in Heaven. (Dwell=Return)
- \* Heb 13:20 ¶ Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that **great Shepherd** of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.





# Psalms 24 - The Chief Shepherd

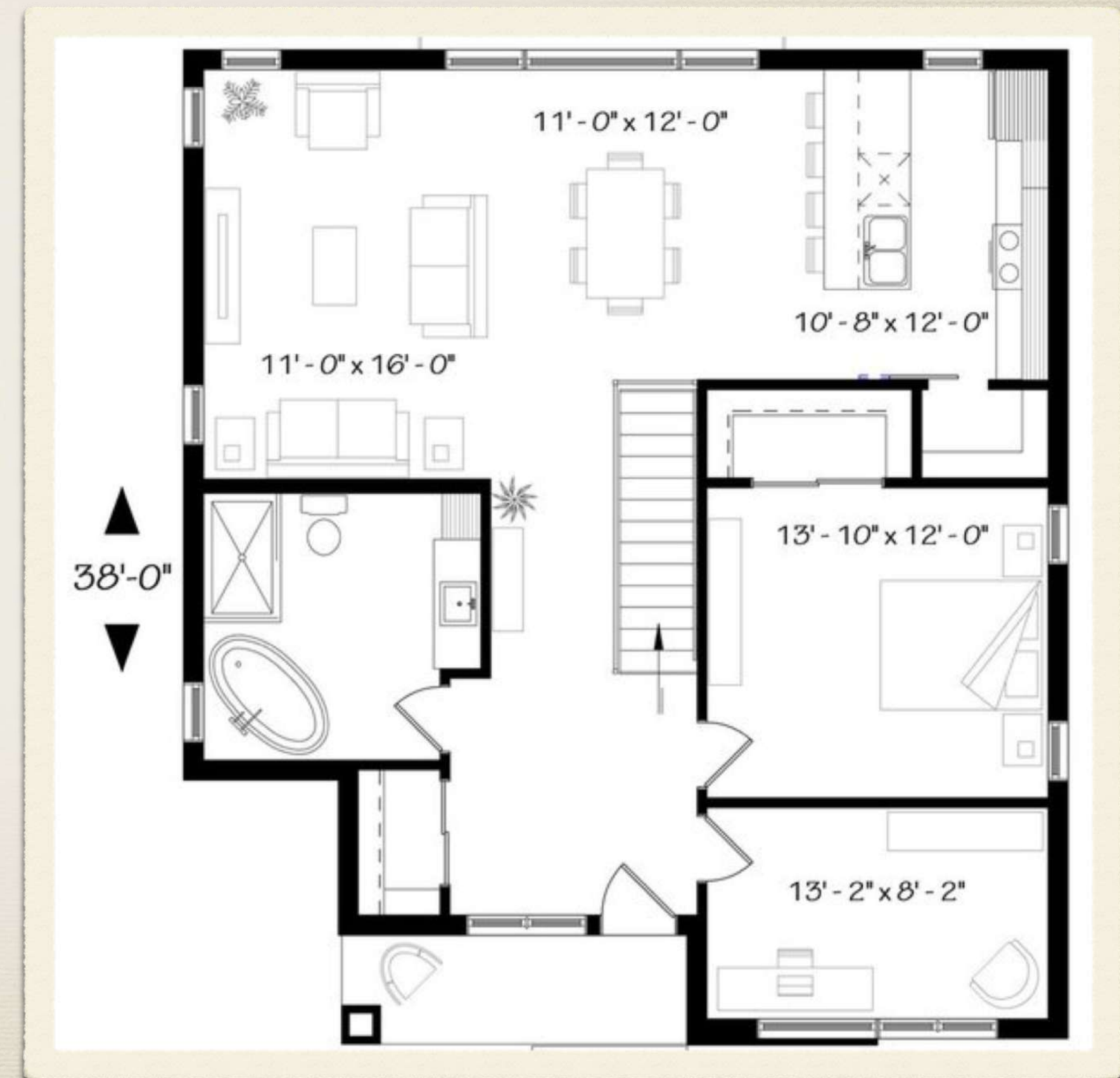
- \* Vs 1-2 Speak of God “The Creator.”
- \* Vs 3-6 Speak of God “Our Redeemer.”
- \* Vs 7-10 Speak of God, the “Returning Judge.”
- \* Prophetically, Gates refer to Governments.
- \* Hosts = Armies.
- \* 1Pe 5:4 and when the **Chief Shepherd** appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.





# His Plan for you.

- \* Creator - Designed by Him. **Origin**
- \* Redeemer - Bought for him. **Purpose**
- \* Judge - Answerable to Him. **Destiny**





# The End of the Rebels

- \* Psalms 24 His Return / Rev 6-19 The Events
- \* This is a worldwide event. Rev 1:7 ¶ Behold, He is coming with clouds, and **every eye will see Him**, even **they who pierced Him**. (The Dead) And **all the tribes of the earth** will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen.
- \* Also Dreaded by the world, Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, **every** slave and **every** free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, 16 and said to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! 17 “For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?”





# All the Angels & All the Saints

- \* Mat 25:31 ¶“When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and **all** the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.
- \* Jde 1:14 ¶And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, **the Lord** cometh **with ten thousands of his saints**, Jde 1:15 To execute judgment upon **all**, and to convince **all** that are ungodly among them of **all** their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of **all** their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against **him**.
- \* 10,000 translated from greek as “Myriad.” Defined, a countless or extremely great number.



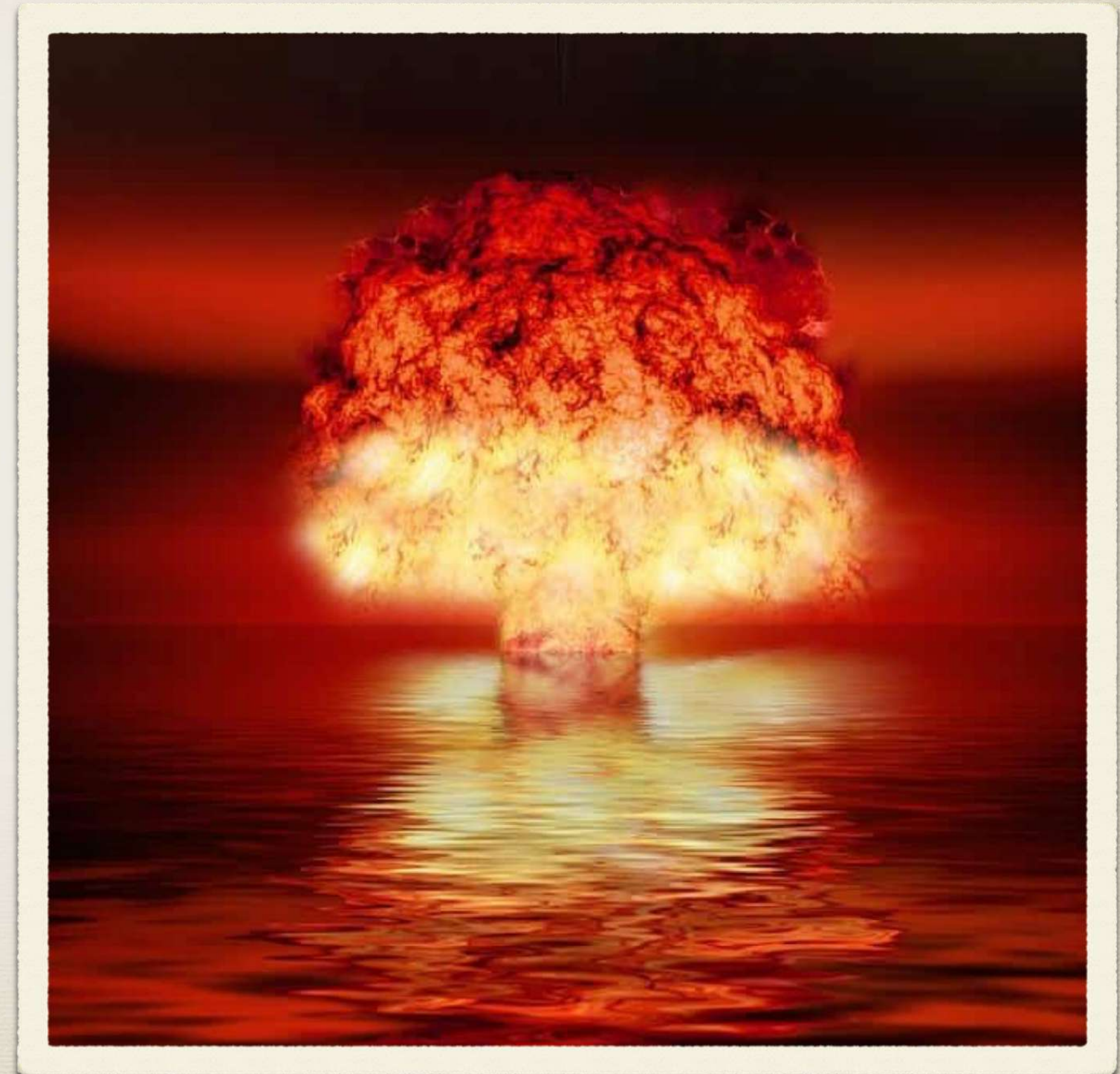
# Sentencing

# It is Nuclear

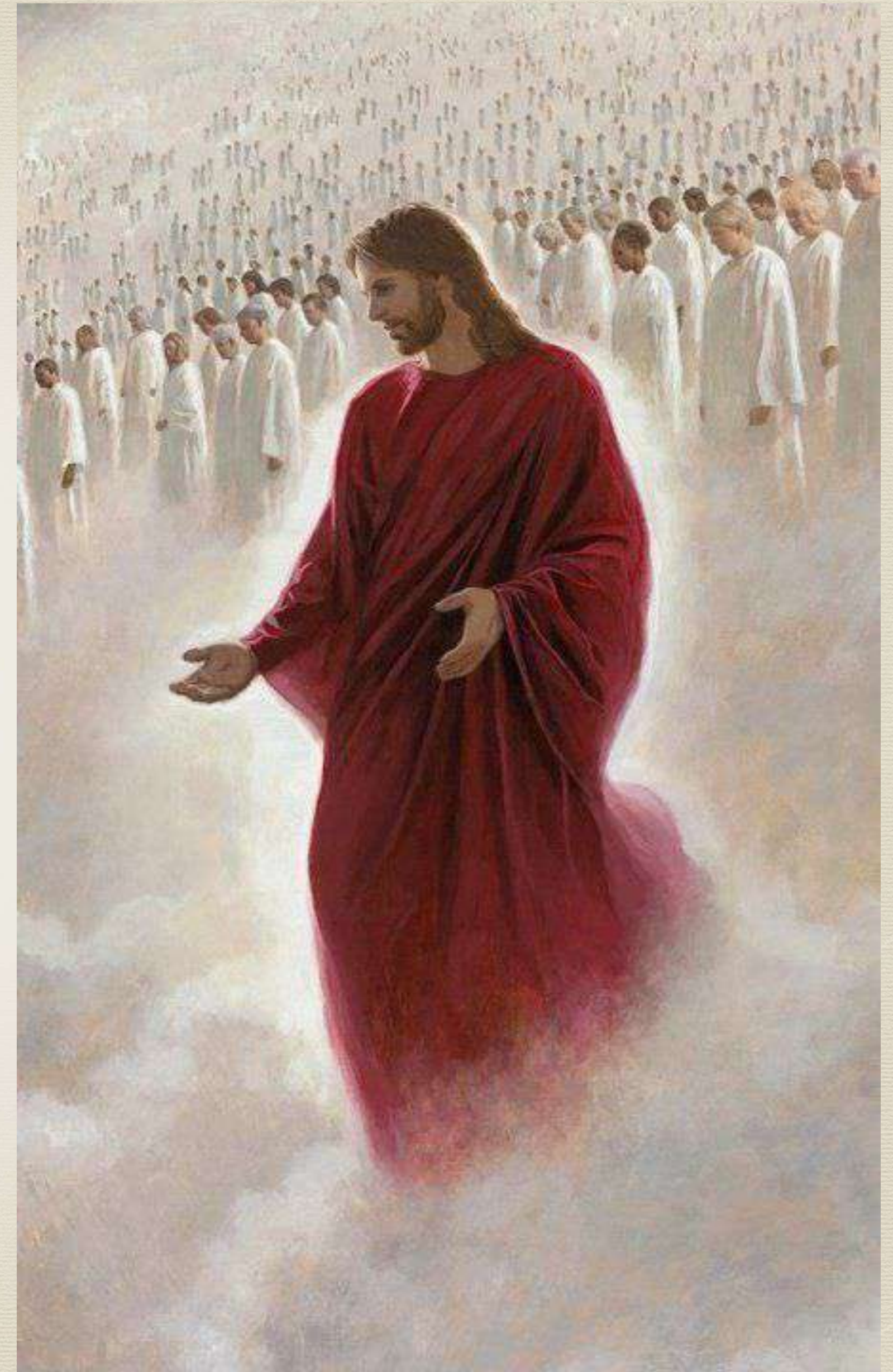
- \* Zec 14:12 ¶ And this shall be the plague wherewith the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.





# Aftermath

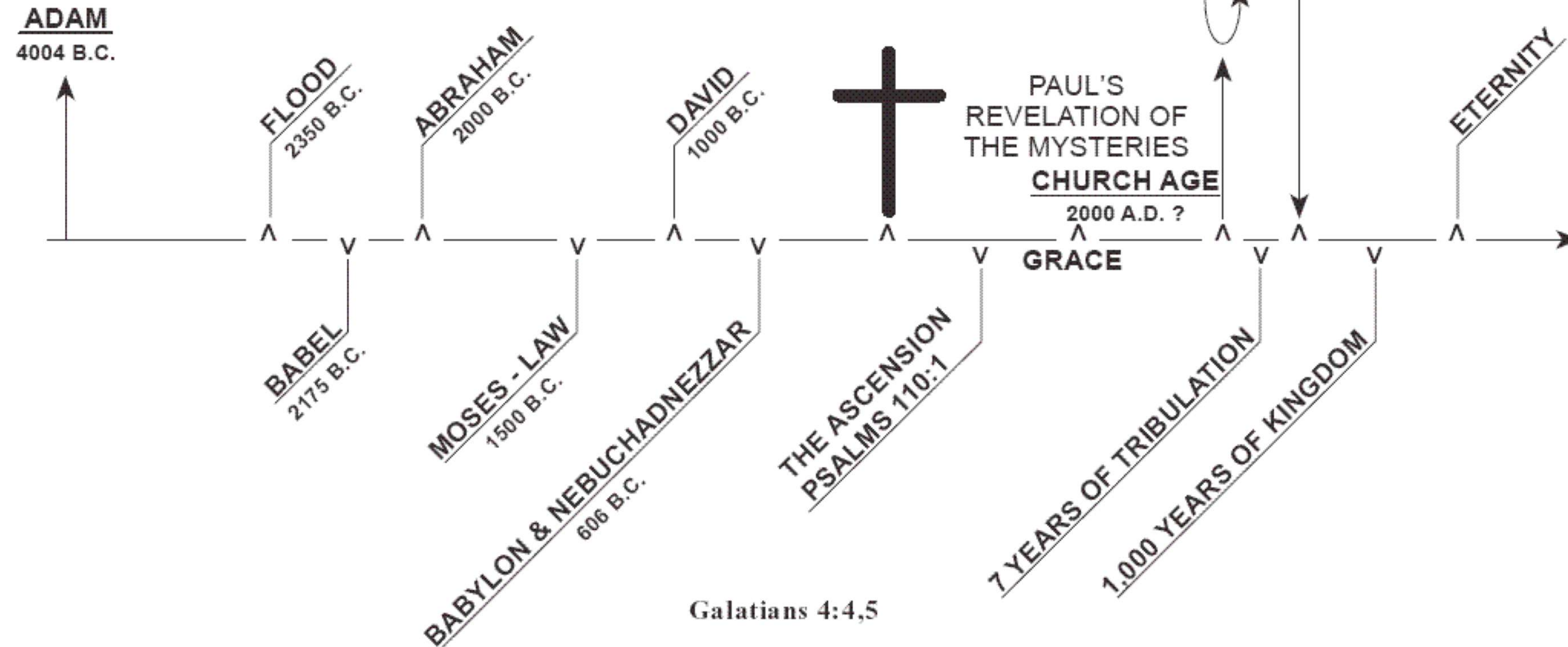
- \* Isa 63:1 ¶ Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.
- \* Isa 63:2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?
- \* Isa 63:3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for **I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.**
- \* Isa 63:4 For **the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.**

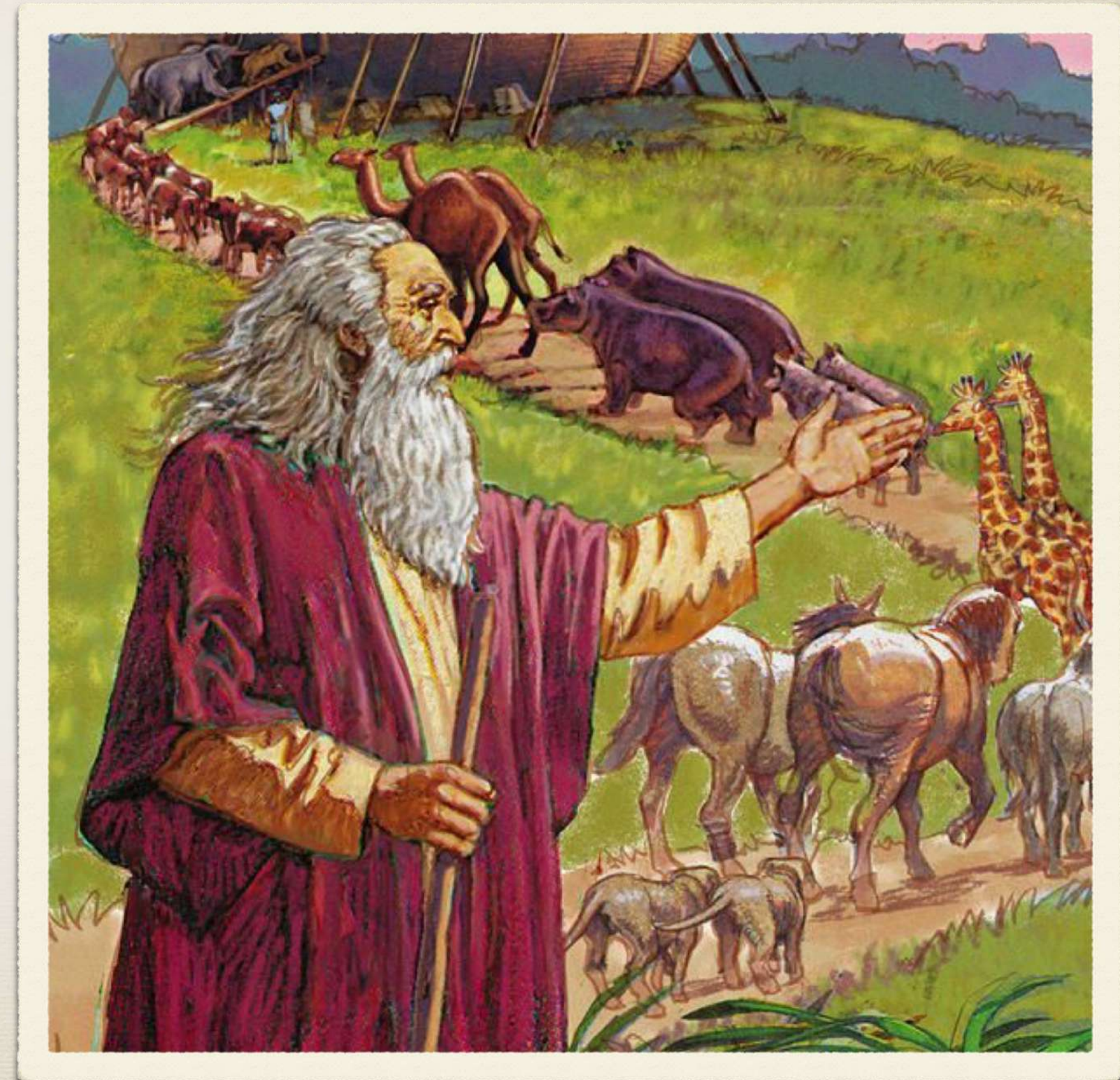

# One more Prophetic Timeline

- \* Gen 6:3 ¶ And the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive (Abide) with man forever, for he is indeed **flesh**; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.”
- \* This verse is during the days of Noah, squeezed between the story of the “watchers” and “there were Giants living in the land in those days.”
- \* Moses also lived 120 years. Moses Wrote Leviticus.
- \* A Jubilee Year., Is 7, 7's or 49 years and begins on the 50th Year. It is a time of Rest, forgiveness of all debts and a freeing of all slaves to go home to their native land. Land is released to ancestral owners. It is announced with the blowing of a Rams Horn on the day of Atonement.
- \* Now, most people do not live to be 120 years old. But God said this would be the number of our days. Perhaps he meant something else, something we don't understand. His ways are not our ways.



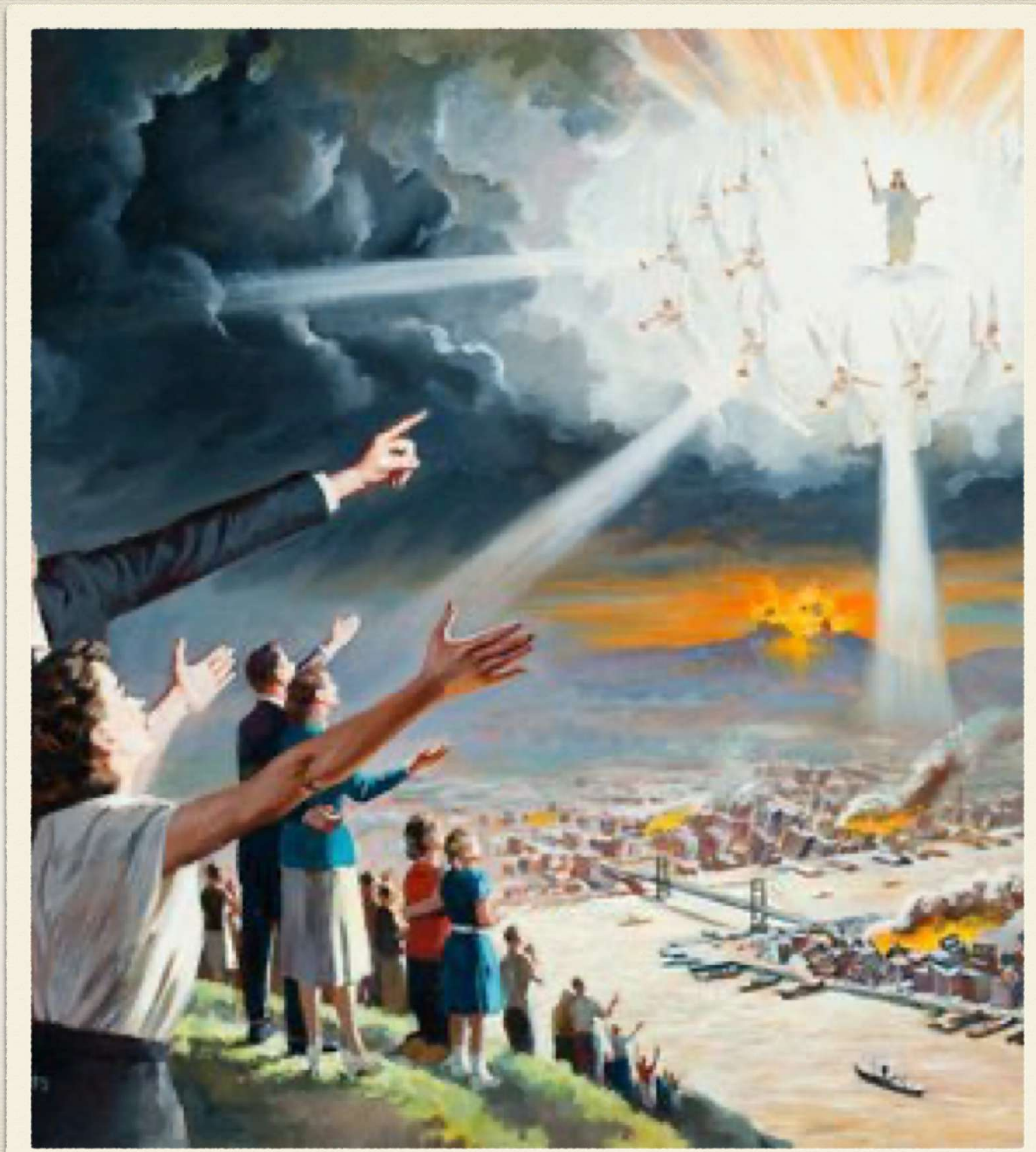

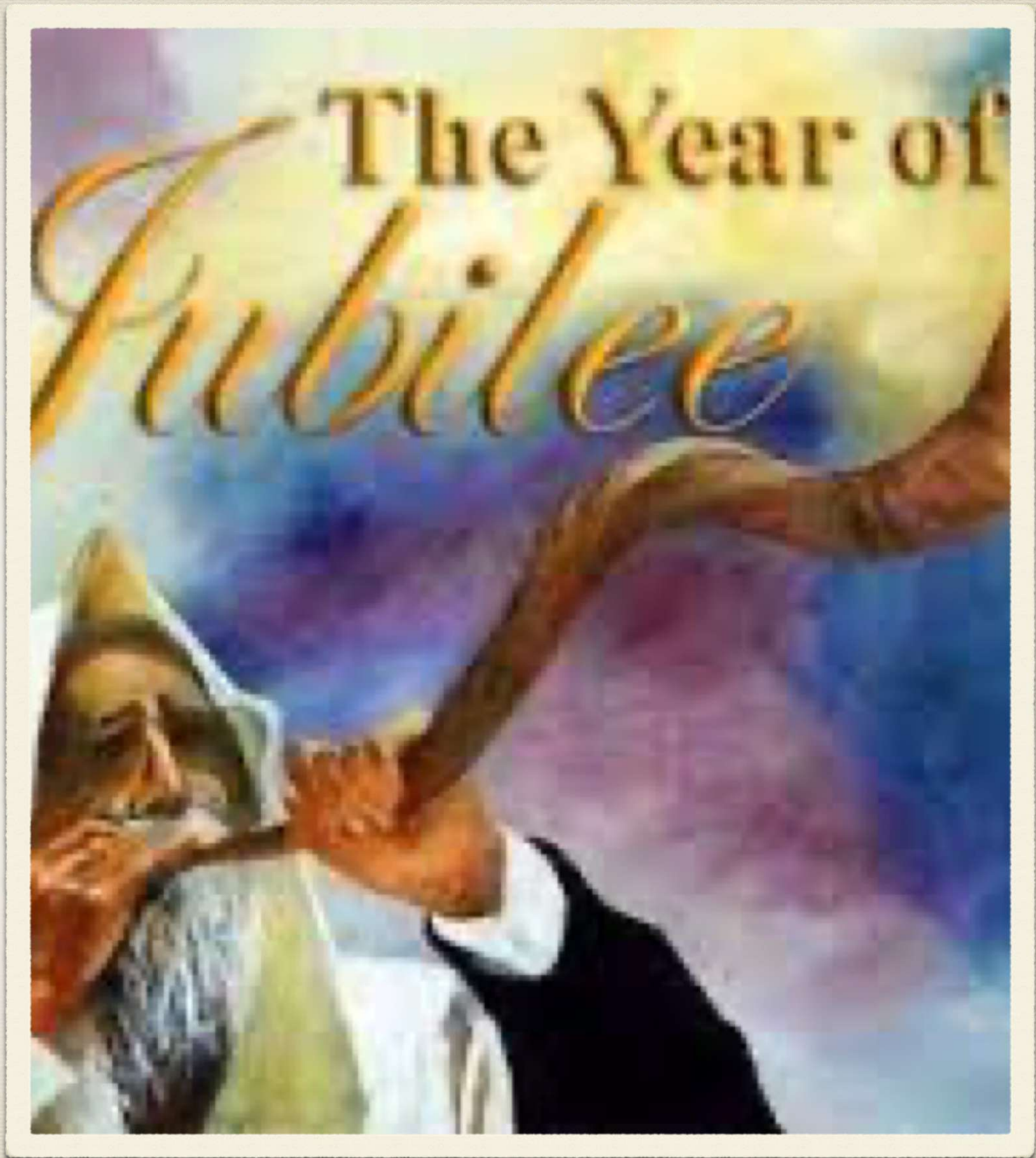
